**Smart Start Strategic Plan Goal(s): Review Data**

- The team is focusing on children in households that are food insecure—14.8% in 2021 from 20.2% in 2019. Feeling is that during COVID more opportunities were available for food that are not available now so this number may not be accurate.
- The second data point the team wants to impact is children without health insurance at 11.7% in 2021 which is up from 9.9% in 2020 which increased from 9.2% in 2019.
