<p>Presentations</p>	<p>Sam provided attendees with an overview of the programs offered through Youth Villages. Assessments are available at 3 years old however services will not start until 4 for intercept and High-fidelity wraparound. Intercept is for 4- to 21-year-olds. Medicaid needed 4 to 5 hrs. a week over 3 days. Uses collaborative problem solving. It lasts about 5 to 6 months. 1 person team per family. If there is no plan for reunification, the family will not qualify. Availability for this program with no waitlist. High-fidelity wraparound is used when an individual is involved with multiple systems and things are not working. For 4- to 21-year-olds. Over 5 to 6 months. More of a care management program. Availability for this program with no waitlist. MST must have the guardian involved to learn tools. It lasts about 5 to 6 months. 4 to 5 hrs. 3 days a week. Small team available, unsure availability. LifeSet is for young adults. 30 hours out of the hospital and 60 hours out of SU Treatment. About a month-ish wait.</p>

<p>Smart Start Strategic Plan</p>	<p>A focus for the team is on children in households that are food insecure: 15.5% in 2021 from 22.2% in 2019. The concern is that the number may have dropped, however is still high.</p> <p>A second focus area is teen pregnancy at 40.8 according to the Roadmap of Need County Profile.</p> <p>A third focus area is children without health insurance: 7.9% in 2021 from 6/2% in 2020. A slight increase.</p>
