The concern is that the number may have dropped, however is still high.</p> <p>A second focus area is teen pregnancy at 40.8 according to the Roadmap of Need County Profile.</p> <p>A third focus area is children without health insurance: 7.9% in 2021 from 6/2% in 2020. A slight increase.</p>
